

Trade Agreements Act (TAA) Compliance Statement

REDCOM Laboratories, Inc. is fully compliant with the Trade Agreements Act of 1979, as amended (19 U.S.C. §§ 2501-2581), and specifically adheres to Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 52.225-5 (Trade Agreements) and FAR 25.003 (Definitions).

End Product Compliance — FAR 52.225-5 & FAR 25.003

In accordance with FAR 52.225-5, REDCOM Laboratories, Inc. certifies that all end products delivered under U.S. government contracts are TAA-compliant, U.S. made, or designated country end products as defined in FAR 25.003. Our end products are articles, materials, or supplies ready for their intended purpose without further manufacturing or processing.

All end products offered by REDCOM Laboratories, Inc. are either:

1. **Wholly the growth, product, or manufacture** of the United States or a designated country through production or manufacture at a REDCOM facility in the United States or a designated country; OR
2. **Substantially transformed** at a REDCOM facility in the United States or a designated country into a new and different article of commerce with a name, character, or use distinct from that of the article or articles from which it was transformed.

Our compliance determination is made at the end product level, as required by FAR 52.225-5.

Designated Countries — FAR 25.003

REDCOM Laboratories, Inc.'s end products are either U.S.-made end products designed and assembled at REDCOM's facility in Victor, New York, or are designated country end products as specified in FAR 25.003. Designated countries include:

- **Least Developed Countries:** As designated by the U.S. Trade Representative
- **Caribbean Basin Countries:** As designated under the Caribbean Basin Economic Recovery Act

REDCOM Laboratories, Inc. does not offer end products manufactured or substantially transformed in non-designated countries.

Substantial Transformation Standard

When end products incorporate components from multiple countries, TAA compliance may be established through substantial transformation. Substantial transformation occurs where the manufacturing process results in a new and different article of commerce with a name, character, or use distinct from that of the constituent materials or components provided the transformation takes place in the United States or a designated country. This is the standard set forth in FAR 52.225-5 and FAR 25.003. In administering this standard, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) considers relevant factors including whether the manufacturing process results in a shift in the product's Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (HTSUS) classification and whether substantial value has been added in the transforming country.

Compliance Management

REDCOM Laboratories, Inc. maintains a comprehensive Quality Management System (QMS) that inherently has controls designed to ensure end product TAA compliance:

- Country of origin documentation and manufacturing location verification for all end products
- Substantial transformation analysis for end products with multi-source components
- Vendor certifications confirming end product compliance with FAR 52.225-5
- Written procedures, regular internal and external audits, and staff training on end product requirements
- Complete records demonstrating compliance for all government contracts

We commit to delivering only TAA-compliant, U.S. made, or designated country end products on U.S. government contracts, maintaining current knowledge of FAR 25.003 designated country lists, and providing supporting documentation upon request.
